Order Sons and Daughters of Italy in America was established in 1905 to support immigrants from Italy. Membership is currently approximately 34,000 members in nearly 350 lodges with Grand Lodges in 17 states.

OSDIA's mission is to encourage the study of Italian language and culture in schools, preserve Italian culture, traditions, heritage and history, and to promote closer relations with Italy. OSDIA's major charities are supported as well as disaster relief in the U.S., Italy and other countries.

Students are given scholarships at the local, state, and national levels. OSDIA's organizational structure at the national level includes a Supreme Council of elected officers representing all states, a Commission for Social Justice, the anti-defamation branch that fights negative advertising and all activities that stereotype Italian Americans, and the Sons of Italy Foundation, which is the non-profit charitable branch that filters all charity funds from local and state lodges and national fundraisers to our national charities.

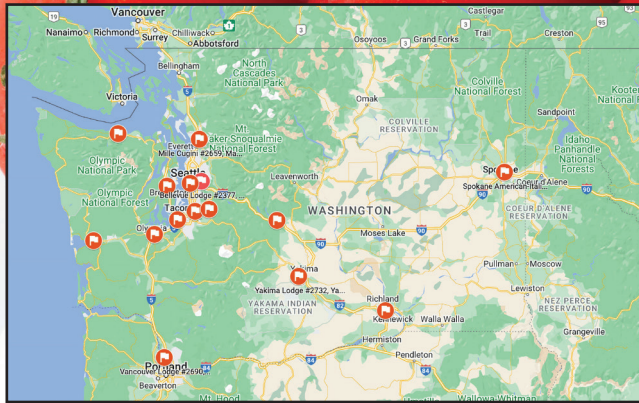

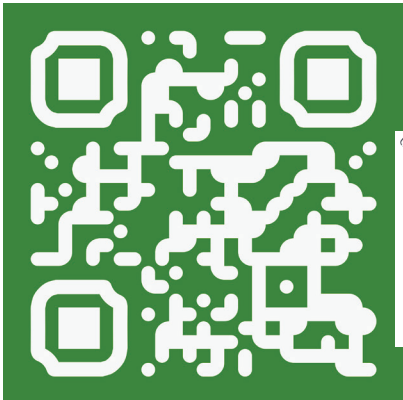
